

Develop your skills to engage ākonga for hybrid learning


Strategies to encourage active learner participation are crucial to a successful hybrid learning approach. Develop the skills and confidence to respond to the needs of ākonga and keep them engaged and excited about their learning, wherever and whenever that learning is taking place.

Delivery: Between 6-10 hours *

Design learning for a hybrid environment

For hybrid learning to be effective, how we plan also needs to change to ensure hybrid strategies are central to learning design from the outset. Design hybrid learning that is learner-centred, transparent and engaging. Explore hybrid-responsive learning content, activities, and assessment for and of learning to create a seamless and engaging experience for all of your ākonga.

Delivery: Between 20-25 hours *



Review effective online learning environments

Educators make decisions everyday about how to create physical environments that are conducive to the learning of their ākonga. Review the interaction of physical and online environments and how your systems ensure that the shift to hybrid learning is smooth, equitable and effective for all.

Delivery: Between 10-12 hours*

Explore ways to keep ākonga safe online

Most education settings have internal firewalls, filtering and monitoring in place to help keep internet use safe on site, but, what happens when some learners are working remotely? Explore a range of strategies to build a culture of safe interactions between online and physical learning spaces to ensure your ākonga are engaging with technology in a positive way.

Delivery: Between 6-10 hours*

Assessment in hybrid learning environments

Fair and equal assessment is key in a hybrid learning environment. Explore your current assessment strategies and how they can be adapted to a hybrid environment. Create an approach to assessment that is based on the use of co-constructed rubrics which help ākonga to succeed on their own terms.

Delivery: Between 8-10 hours*
