

Facilitation Notes: Digital outcomes - challenge yourself with progress outcome 1

Purpose

These notes are intended to help teachers and leaders facilitate the pīkau *Digital outcomes - challenge yourself with progress outcome 1* to a group of other teachers, for example, in a staff meeting.

Facilitation notes

Section	Facilitation Notes
What you'll learn....	Present this to your group. It should be self explanatory.
Why this matters....	The key point is that developing a wide range of DDDO skills is essential for learners to succeed at they progress through the new digital content. While some of these activities may be challenging - they

	are huge fun and learners will have a great time when they use them.
You might already know some of this....	Many of the terms used in this pīkau will be familiar. For those that are not - write them on the board and check at the end of the meeting if they have been understood.
Expand your digital toolkit	<p>This section is intended to be browsed through. One approach - depending on the size of your staff - and available time - could be to split the staff in to groups, and each group reads/watches a different section and reports back briefly to the rest of the staff.</p> <p>For each section, reflect on where the activity being outlined could fit in to your school/own curriculum/programmes of learning.</p> <p>Each section has a video summary that includes further useful details including NZC levels, time frames, teaching tips and resources used.</p> <p>The resources are simply starter ones to get you going!</p>
Multiple choice quiz	This can be done individually or in pairs/groups.
Link to programme design	<p>The videos should get you thinking about how and where you can use them in your own classroom. Challenge yourself to use them in an authentic context - one where learners are producing a digital outcome for a genuine purpose that has not been contrived.</p> <p>Having a brief discussion about this as a school would help generate further ideas.</p>
Wrapping up	<p>The nature of the progress outcomes means that learners will move unevenly from one to the next. Providing challenging activities such as the ones outlined in this pīkau will keep learners interested and enable them to develop further their skills and knowledge.</p> <p>Teachers, will also need to develop and expand their professional knowledge. Participating in Ngā Kiriahi will provide an opportunity to work with other</p>

	teachers in developing ideas for implementing the material covered in this pīkau.
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
